Video Interview

The video interview is a chance for you to represent yourself as a good candidate for the ILA. Through these recorded videos, we evaluate your:

- 1. academic and scholastic capacity and communication skills;
- 2. motivation and commitment to our liberal arts program;
- 3. familiarity with current events and academic topics;
- 4. intellectual curiosity;
- 5. social aptitude and leadership.

As a reference, the criteria for each of the four video recordings is as follows:


- Video 1: Self-introduction and Motivation
- Video 2: Critical Thinking and Analytic Skills
- Video 3: Subject Knowledge and Interest
- Video 4: Communication and Collaboration Skills

Video Interview Procedures

Please review carefully the following video interview procedures before you begin.

If you have any concerns, please contact the ILA Admissions Office (ji-ila@mail.doshisha.ac.jp) before you begin your interview. Once you begin the video recording you will not be able to pause the interview.

- 1. After you have submitted all required application documents, you will receive <u>an</u> <u>email with a link</u> to proceed with your video interview.
- 2. You <u>must</u> complete the video interview <u>within seven days</u> (no more than 168 hours) after receiving the link. The link will <u>expire after 168 hours</u> at which point your application will be <u>invalidated</u>.
- 3. <u>Check your computing device</u>, including the webcam and microphone, by following the instructions on the interview site in our online application system.
- 4. There are <u>four questions</u> in total and you will be given <u>150 seconds</u> to answer <u>each</u> question.
- 5. The interview will start approximately <u>ten seconds</u> after you press the "start" button.
- 6. The interview will only be recorded <u>once</u> (one attempt). You will not be able to re-record.
- 7. After you begin the recording, the interview will proceed <u>non-stop</u> from one question to the next. You must complete all four questions <u>in succession</u>. You will not be able to pause the recording or return to a question.
- 8. Please note the <u>position of the interview questions</u> on the page below. (Note that the remaining wording is the same for each question.)
